School & District

Dublin is a rapidly growing, upper-middle class, suburban, residential community located northwest of Columbus, Ohio. The majority of the residents are professional and business people employed in Columbus. Dublin Scioto High School is a four-year high school, with an enrollment of 1241 and 291 senior students in the 2010-2011 graduating class. Dublin is fully accredited by both the State of Ohio Department of Education and North Central Association of Secondary Schools and Colleges. Dublin Scioto High School has 114 certificated staff. Of these, 97 have earned Master's Degrees.

Graduation Requirements

The curriculum at Dublin Scioto is comprehensive, including advanced placement, honors, occupational, vocational and adjusted programs. Twenty-one units of credit are required for graduation. Specific requirements include the following:

Advanced Placement

Honors courses are available in English I, II, III, Algebra II, Geometry, Precalculus, French IV and V, Spanish IV and V, German IV, Latin IV, and Japanese IV. Advanced Placement courses are offered in English Language, English Literature, Environmental Science, Biology, Chemistry, Physics B, Physics C, Computer Science A, Statistics, Calculus AB and Calculus BC, United States History, World History, European History and U.S. Government and Politics. Transcripts are noted accordingly. In the 2011 school year 356 students took 651 tests, resulting in the following scores:
5 = 16% **4 = 22%** **3 = 26%** **2 = 22%** **1 = 13%**

The International Baccalaureate Program

Dublin Scioto High School became an authorized International Baccalaureate (IB) World School in February 2008. The following IB courses are offered: English HL (2 year course), Spanish B SL & HL (2 year courses), French Ab Initio SL (2 year course), Spanish Ab Initio SL (2 year course), History of the Americas HL (2 year course), Psychology SL (1 year course), Biology HL (2 year course), Environmental Systems & Societies SL (1 year course), Chemistry SL (1 year course), Physics SL (1 year course), Math HL (2 year course), Math SL (2 year course), Math Studies SL (2 year course), Visual Arts SL and HL (2 year courses), and Theatre SL and HL (2 year courses).

Weighted Grades

(Prior to 2008-2009 School Year)

Dublin uses a weighted grade system for honors and Advanced Placement courses. A factor of 1.0 is added to honors courses and Advanced Placement courses. A grade of a D+ and lower in honors or Advanced Placement courses does not receive the added point value.

Weighted Grades

(Began 2008-2009 School Year)

Honors courses receive an additional .5 value. Grades of D+ and lower do not receive the added point value. **Advanced Placement & International Baccalaureate** courses receive an additional 1.0 value. Grades of D+ and lower do not receive the added point value.

Class Rank

Due to the competitiveness of Dublin Scioto High School, rank is not reported.

Scholastic Recognition

The Class of 2010 had 8 National Merit Commended Scholars, 1 National Achievement Finalist and 8 International Baccalaureate Diploma recipients. Other awards include: National Honor Society, Advanced Placement Scholar Awards, and Academic Excellence Awards.
